Tram Grade Separation Project

Marion Road and Cross Road Level Crossing Removals works notification

We're removing congested tram level crossings to make your journey safer and more reliable

The Tram Grade Separation Projects will be carrying out a major infrastructure project along Pleasant Avenue, Plympton that will have temporary changes to local traffic access.

When
From Wednesday 18 June for up to six weeks, weather permitting.

Pleasant Avenue between Marion Road, Cross Road and Mark Avenue, Plympton

What's happening
From Wednesday 18 June 2025, we will begin work to install a temporary road closure along Pleasant Avenue for up to six weeks. This work is part of the Marion Road and Cross Road Level Crossing Removals project and is required ahead of permanent construction starting. Our work activities include:

- establishing a temporary work site along Pleasant Avenue with temporary fencing and signs; the temporary closure is a temporary closure to allow for the new infrastructure.

How this affects you
From Wednesday 18 June 2025, access to Pleasant Avenue will be temporarily closed between Cross Street and Cross Road for approximately three weeks. This closure is required to safely facilitate ongoing works. During this period, alternative access to Pleasant Avenue will be via Marion Street. Local access for residents on Pleasant Avenue between Cross Street and Mark Avenue will be via Marion Street.

From early July, access to Pleasant Avenue from Marion Road will be temporarily closed for approximately three weeks. Alternative access will be via Cross Road. We will maintain local traffic access along Pleasant Avenue with a one-way westbound lane between Cross Street and Mark Avenue. Please see map below for further detail on these temporary changes.


We will need to temporarily close Pleasant Avenue between Marion Road and Cross Street in order to safely manage traffic management measures as our work activities change. We will schedule these temporary closures outside of peak travel times.

Prohibition access will be maintained along Pleasant Avenue for the duration of all work in this area.

Vegetation removals
While early effort has been made to remove existing vegetation and trees, any removals are required as part of the works to facilitate the installation of the infrastructure. For further information on any cut and vegetation management and how we will be offsetting removals across the projects, please visit our website to see our Landscape Plan and Vegetation Plan (see 18.02.2025).

Mike Turtur Bikeway temporary closure
There will be a temporary closure of the Mike Turtur Bikeway between Cross Street and Cross Road. There will be a temporary closure around the work area. Please refer to the map below for further information on this project website.
